Active members are required to pay the basic subscription plus the additional subscription for tennis and/or hockey and/or cricket. Passive members only pay the basic subscription, honorary members nothing.

Juveniles are defined as all under-18s plus school pupils, students, trainees/apprentices and young people doing military service or social work up to the age of 25 providing proof of this status is supplied.

Work for the club

1. Every active member is required to do 5 hours of work for the club per year; members who have entered their 80th year of life are exempted.
2. Working for the club may take one of the following forms:
 - Work on the grounds on two dates a year, each announced well in advance
 - Membership of a specific work group within the club
 - Special assignments agreed with the Executive Committee, and in particular: supervision of a children's team, work on specific projects, work at the club house, etc.
3. Juveniles over the age of 14 are required do the work themselves.
 The parents or guardians of members under 14 are required to do their work.
 Any exceptions to these rules must be agreed with the Executive Committee.
4. No family is required to work more than 10 hours a year.
5. Members are required to pay €5 for each hour of work they have failed to perform in a year.

Payment

1. Any bank fees for return debit notes resulting from errors for which the club is not responsible, e.g. wrong bank details, insufficient credit on the account, non-justified return of a debit note, etc, have to be paid by the member in question.
2. If a member does not agree to the bank collection procedure but requires an invoice instead, a fee of €12 per invoice will be charged.
3. If a subscription or a fee for non-fulfilment of voluntary work for the Club or a fee for separately agreed training sessions is not paid on time - and the Club is not responsible for that non-payment -, a fee of €12 will be charged for each reminder.-
